Does your company have drivers?

If so, it may be to your advantage to enroll in the California Employer Pull Notice Program (EPN)

Do you know if your drivers have had a ticket within the last month? Do you know if their license has been suspended? As an employer, it is critical that you identify and control all of your company's exposures. If you have company vehicles or employees who drive their personal vehicles for company purposes you have a large exposure that is out of your control as soon as your employees leave your place of business. The EPN Program is key to helping you identify a problem driver ***BEFORE*** he/she harms themselves or someone else.

The DMV established the program to promote driver safety by providing employers the means to have an ongoing review of the driving records of their employed commercial licensed drivers. Employers with non-commercial drivers can enroll in the program as well. Each employer enrolled in the program is issued an account with an assigned requester code that is added to each identified employee's driver license record.

By monitoring your drivers DMV records you will know if your drivers have valid licenses, if they are problem drivers or are developing negative driving habits, which will help to reduce your liability.

When will DL records of enrolled drivers be provided?

Record printouts will automatically generate and sent to you for the following reasons:

- ◆ Upon enrollment of drivers in the EPN Program
- ◆ Annually, every 12 months from either the date of enrollment or the last notification printout
- ◆ Upon any activity on a driver license record (i.e. accident, conviction, suspension, etc.)

Let's ALL be safe and courteous drivers both on AND off the job.
