

### **Does your company have drivers? If so, it may be to your advantage to enroll in the California Employer Pull Notice Program (EPN)**

Do you know if your drivers have had a ticket within the last month? Do you know if their license has been suspended? As an employer, it is critical that you identify and manage your company's exposures.

The Employer Pull Notice (EPN) Program was established to provide employers and regulatory agencies with a means of promoting driver safety through the ongoing review of driver records.

The program was developed to monitor commercial licensed drivers. Employers with non-commercial drivers can enroll in the program as well.

By monitoring your drivers DMV records, you will know if your drivers have valid licenses and if they are developing negative driving habits.

#### **When will DL records of enrolled drivers be provided?**

Record printouts are automatically generated and sent to you for the following reasons:

- Upon enrollment of drivers in the EPN Program
- Annually, every 12 months from either the date of enrollment or the last notification printout
- Upon any activity on a driver license record (i.e. accident, citation, suspension)
